USTA North Carolina Junior Team Tennis Requirements for Levels of Play

12U, 14U & 18U Rating Bands:

- 0.0 2.2 Beginner Level
- 2.3 3.0 Intermediate Level
- 3.1 7.0 Advanced Level

10U Participants must play Advanced if:

- NTRP of 3.1 and above in any division (will only have one if they play up)
- 1 100 USTA Southern Standing in any age group as of July 31, 2019 and/or December 31, 2019
- Click Here to look up a July 31, 2019 Southern Standing
- Click Here to look up a December 31, 2019 Southern Standing (Select Southern; Year 2019; the division; Standing List * click Find It. You will refer to the list dated 1/3/19.)

10U Participants must play in the Intermediate Division if the following criteria applies:

- NTRP of 2.2 and above in any division (will only have one if they play up)
- North Carolina Standing with 175 points or more as of December 31, 2019
- <u>Click Here</u> to look up a December 31, 2019 Standing List for North Carolina (Select Southern North Carolina; Year 2019; the division you need; Standing List and click Find It. Look at 1/5/2019 Published this is the December 31, 2019 list.)

^{*}You may choose to play UP one level, but not DOWN. Example: A player rated 2.3 - 3.0 could choose to play UP, but not DOWN in beginner.

^{**}Rating bands will apply to those who currently have a rating. If you do not have a rating, you may participate in the beginner or intermediate division.

^{***}If you would like to require self-rating at the local level, you may do so.
